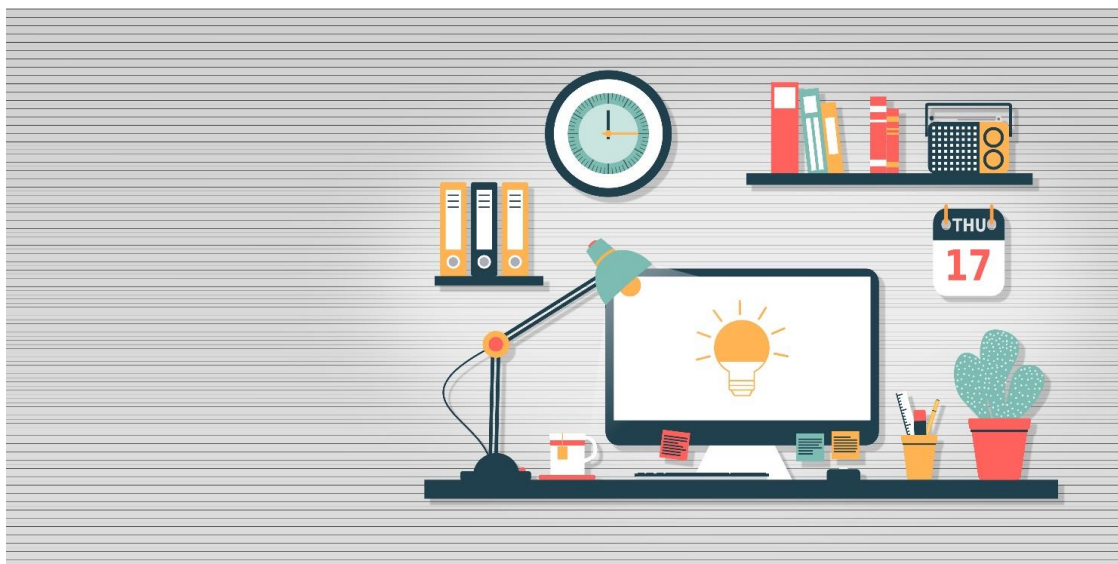


Volunteering Opportunities
