Purpose of the Role

Mr Hastings and St Leonards has been funded for three years, from June 2022, by East Sussex County Council. It is hosted by Hastings Voluntary Action and led by local men.

The project's long-term vision is that men living in Hastings and St Leonards are living happier, healthier, and longer lives. They are at the heart of decision making about their lives and thrive in strong, supportive, and well-connected communities, where they can fulfil their potential.

This is a new role which sits within the innovative Mr Hastings and St Leonards Project Team.

This post will:

- Be based in the Hastings Voluntary Action (HVA) offices at Jackson Hall in Hastings but will be required to travel across Hastings and St Leonards on a regular basis.
- Receive Line Management support from the Project Manager.
- Work closely, on a day-to-day basis, with the Project's Community Development Worker, and core group of local men, who are leading the projects development and delivery and exploring options around sustainability.

The Assistant Community Development Worker will be engaging with men, and the wider community, in Hastings and St Leonards through an Asset Based Community Development (ABCD) approach as highlighted in the main tasks below.

With the relevant support and training, the post holder will be allocated specific tasks aligned with the Mr Hastings and St Leonards Delivery Plan and will be encouraged to recognise, and build on, their own skills and experience.

Main Tasks

Community Engagement and Communication

- Support the team in the design, delivery, and administration of engagement activities.
- Support the development, and implementation, of good practice across Mr Hastings and St Leonards initiatives.
- Make connections and build relationships within the community.
- Support the development and delivery of online engagement/digital inclusion opportunities.

Collaborative Working

- Work in collaboration with local men and wider stakeholders.
- Encourage, and engage in, conversations around men's health and wellbeing across Hastings and St Leonards.
- Build and maintain strong working relationships with local men, community groups, voluntary organisations and services that support men across Hastings and St Leonards.

Learning and Development

- Support the collection of 'evidence of impact' alongside the project team and learning/evaluation partners Apteligen.
- Support men from Mr Hastings and St Leonards to access local learning and development opportunities.
- Participate fully in training/learning opportunities in the workplace and within the local community.

Other

- The varied nature of the role requires flexibility to undertake other appropriate and relevant duties as they occur.
- Attend training/development programmes and staff meetings/briefings.
- Work collaboratively as part of HVA's staff team towards the aims and objectives of the organisation.
- Carry out responsibilities and duties within the framework of HVA's policies, including HVA's Equal Opportunities and HVA's Health and Safety Policy.
- Be an Ambassador/Champion for Mr Hastings and Leonards and Hastings Voluntary Action.
- Undertake any other duties as required which are in line with the post.
