ESCC Family Hubs Aquababes Volunteer - an integral part of our team, helping and supporting community nursery nurses with new parents accessing a 6 week water confidence course with their babies at the local pool. The sessions take place on Thursday mornings. Volunteers are not required to get in the water but to help parents before and after the session in the changing rooms. You will need to be patient, supportive and happy to hold young babies. All volunteers receive full induction training (some of which is online) and undergo an enhanced DBS check.
