The Isabel Blackman Centre (IBC) is a much-loved community venue in the heart of Hastings' Old Town, providing a haven for health, wellbeing and leisure. Facilities include an exercise studio and gym, café restaurant, activity and event space, treatment rooms, accessible bathing facilities and a community shop. Designed specifically for the over 50's but a venue that everyone in the community can enjoy. After a period of closure the IBC is re-opening, and they are recruiting for a wide range of volunteers to support the centre. Diabetes UK are seeking Community Champions to volunteer in the Hastings area. Champions educate and raise awareness of diabetes and Diabetes UK by organising stalls, talks, presentations and healthy living days at community centres, health fairs and local festivals. They reach out into communities that are more at risk of Diabetes helping people to be aware of their risk and signposting to help in the local area. The Guide Dogs for the Blind Association – Do you have a few spare hours each week to improve the life of a person living with sight loss? You will undergo training and learn to safely guide someone with sight loss, navigating environments and building self-confidence – all whilst increasing social interaction with those who may not otherwise wish to leave their home. We match the volunteer and the person with support needs carefully to make sure that they have things in common and will enjoy spending time together.
